5 Sandford Report

Chris advised that he had received a reply from SLC Planning Dept confirming that planning consent had been granted at Springside Farm and that following the demolition works the concern over the asbestos material had been monitored and deemed not to be hazardous.

It was agreed not to proceed with the erection of a sign at the Play Park, which SLC had advised would cost £239. Following discussion it was agreed it would be preferable to purchase a bench and insert a plaque.

PM advised that the Hall Committee had recently increased the cost of renting the Hall. AC proposed, and it was agreed, that all future meetings should be booked for a 2-hour slot at a cost of £30. This will allow extra discussion time for KMCP matters.
